WHITE-FRONTED CHAT

EASTERN SPINEBILL – feed on blossom

NEW HOLLAND HONEYEATER

WHITE-PLUMED HONEYEATER

WHITE-EARED HONEYEATER – busy in spring

YELLOW-FACED HONEYEATER – migrates in
autumn to Q'ld

NOISY MINER

LITTLE WATTLEBIRD – no wattles

RED WATTLEBIRD

BROWN THORNBILL

STRIATED THORNBILL

YELLOW-RUMPED THORNBILL

WHITE-BROWED SCRUB WREN

SUPERB BLUE WREN – needs low vegetation
(1m high)

WILLY WAGTAIL

GREY FANTAIL

RESTLESS FLYCATCHER

LITTLE GREY (SHRIKE) THRUSH

SONG THRUSH - introduced

RUFUS WHISTLER – uncommon

EASTERN SHRIKE TIT – insects under bark

STRAW-NECKED IBIS – may be seen in flight
